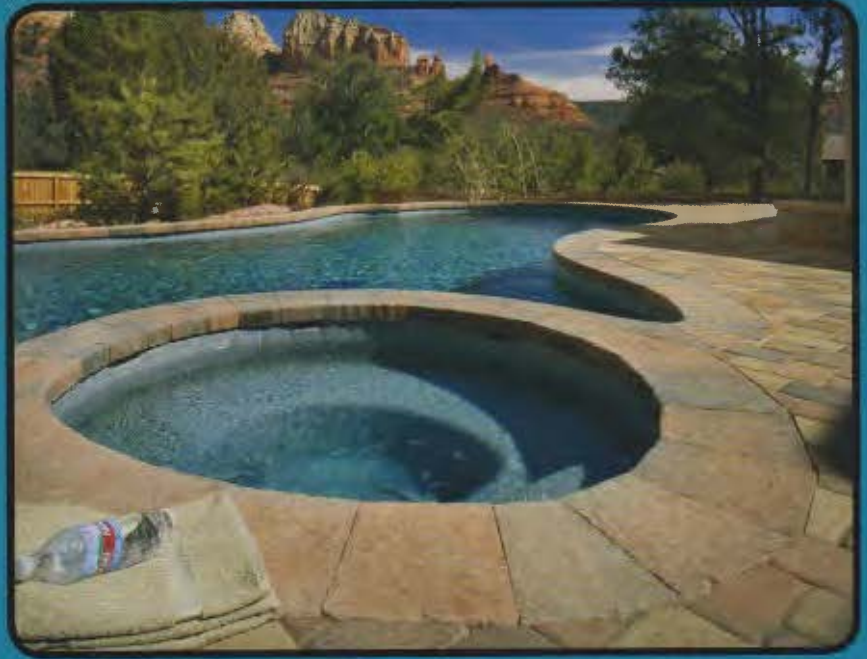


# Who Is ICPI?

Are they insured and licensed by the AZ Registrar of Contractors?

Can they provide proof in insurance as well as local/state license?

Does the contractor guarantee their work for a minimum of 2 years?

How long has the contractor been installing pavers and retaining walls?

Will they provide references/projects in the area?

Do you have more than one quote?

Do they charge extra for cuts?

What are their change order policies?
